- (I) SHALL REPORT WEEKLY MONTHLY TO THE DEPARTMENT THE NAMES, ADDRESSES, AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS OF THE MASTER HUNTING GUIDE'S FIELD ASSISTANTS, AND THE TYPE, KINDS, AND TOTAL NUMBERS OF WILD WATERFOWL THAT ARE KILLED DAILY BY-ALL OF-THE-HUNTERS AND THE NAMES AND LICENSE NUMBERS OF THE HUNTERS THAT THE MASTER HUNTING GUIDE OUTFITS OR GUIDES, WHETHER PERSONALLY OR BY AGENT, EMPLOYEE, HELPER, OR WALKER; AND
- (II) IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, OR HELPERS OF THE HUNTING OUTFITTERS WHILE IN THE COURSE OF EMPLOYMENT.
- (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT REQUIRE THE DAILY REPORTS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO BE DIVIDED BY THE NUMBER OF WILD WATERFOWL KILLED BY HUNTERS WHO ARE GUIDED BY A MASTER HUNTING GUIDE'S AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, OR HELPERS.
- (#) (J) A MASTER HUNTING GUIDE MAY NOT OUTFIT OR GUIDE ANY HUNTER OF WILD WATERFOWL UNLESS THE HUNTER POSSESSES A PROPER HUNTER'S LICENSE.
- (d) (K) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LAW TO THE CONTRARY, AND EXCEPT FOR A MASTER HUNTING GUIDE REGISTERING THE FIELD ASSISTANTS WITH THE DEPARTMENT, THE SECRETARY OR ANY OFFICIAL OF THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ADOPT ANY RULE OR REGULATION CONCERNING THE LICENSING OF AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, OR HELPERS OF A MASTER HUNTING GUIDE WHO GUIDE HUNTERS TO HUNT WILD WATERFOWL.
- (2) ANY--RUBE--OR--REGULATION---THAT---REQUIRES---THE LICENSING--OF--AGENTS,--EMPLOYEES,-OR-HELPERS-OF-A-MASTER-HUNTING GUIDE-WHILE-GUIDING-HUNTERS-TO-HUNT-WILD--WATERFOWL--IS--DEGLARED NULL,-VOID,-AND-OF-NO-EFFECT:
- (3) THE STATE OR ANY OF ITS AGENCIES OR DEPARTMENTS MAY NOT REQUEST THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO ENFORCE ANY FEDERAL RULE OR REGULATION CONCERNING THE LICENSING OF AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, OR HELPERS OF A MASTER HUNTING GUIDE WHO GUIDE HUNTERS TO HUNT WILD WATERFOWL.

## (4) (3) THE DEPARTMENT:

- (I) SHALL ADOPT NEW RULES OR REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION; AND
- (II) MAY REVOKE THE LICENSE OF ANY MASTER HUNTING GUIDE FOR ANY VIOLATION OF LAW, RULE, OR REGULATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
