BY A LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, OR REGULATION, ANY APPEAL OF THAT ORDER SHALL BE MADE AS PROVIDED BY LAW, ORDINANCE, OR REGULATION OF THE LOCAL JURISDICTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
