

(a)--In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated:

(b)--"Occupant--needing--evacuation--assistance"--means--any person who, because of age, blindness, disability, or physical or mental illness, is unable to evacuate a building in case of fire without assistance.

(c)--"Automatic--fire--extinguishing--system"--means--a system designed to automatically detect and extinguish a fire while sounding an alarm, and installed in accordance with accepted engineering practices as approved by the authority having jurisdiction} STATE-FIRE-PREVENTION-COMMISSION.

(C) (1) IF AN ORDER FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION IS ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AUTHORITY GRANTED UNDER THIS ARTICLE, ANY APPEAL OF THAT ORDER SHALL BE MADE TO THE STATE FIRE PREVENTION COMMISSION.

(2) IF AN ORDER FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION IS ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY A LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, OR REGULATION, ANY APPEAL OF THAT ORDER SHALL BE MADE AS PROVIDED BY LAW, ORDINANCE, OR REGULATION OF THE LOCAL JURISDICTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 515

(Senate Bill 196)

AN ACT concerning

Fire-Rescue Education and Training Commission - Composition
