Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-505 of this subtitle, the Commission, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its full authorized membership, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:

- (22) Is disciplined by a licensing or disciplinary authority or convicted or disciplined by a court of any state or country for an act that would be grounds for disciplinary action under this section;
- (24) Performs an abortion outside a licensed hospital; [or]
- (25) Willfully submits false statements to collect fees for which services are not provided; OR
- (26)--IS--CONVICTED--OF--OFFENSES,--RELATING--TO---THE COMPETENCY-TO-PRACTICE-AS-A-PHYSICIAN,-THAT-OCCURRED-IN-ANY-OTHER STATE--WHEN-THE-LICENSEE-WAS-LICENSED-TO-PRACTICE-MEDICINE-IN-THE OTHER-STATE:
- ACTION BY A LICENSING OR DISCIPLINARY AUTHORITY OR BY A COURT OF ANY STATE OR COUNTRY FOR AN ACT THAT WOULD BE GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION AND THE LICENSEE:
- (I) SURRENDERED THE LICENSE ISSUED BY THE STATE OR COUNTRY; OR
- (II) ALLOWED THE LICENSE ISSUED BY THE STATE OR COUNTRY TO EXPIRE OR LAPSE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
