

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-505 of this subtitle, the Commission, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its full authorized membership, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:

(22) Is disciplined by a licensing or disciplinary authority or convicted or disciplined by a court of any state or country for an act that would be grounds for disciplinary action under this section;

(24) Performs an abortion outside a licensed hospital; [or]

(25) Willfully submits false statements to collect fees for which services are not provided; OR

~~(26) IS CONVICTED OF OFFENSES, RELATING TO THE COMPETENCY TO PRACTICE AS A PHYSICIAN, THAT OCCURRED IN ANY OTHER STATE WHEN THE LICENSEE WAS LICENSED TO PRACTICE MEDICINE IN THE OTHER STATE.~~

(26) WAS SUBJECT TO INVESTIGATION OR DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY A LICENSING OR DISCIPLINARY AUTHORITY OR BY A COURT OF ANY STATE OR COUNTRY FOR AN ACT THAT WOULD BE GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION AND THE LICENSEE:

(I) SURRENDERED THE LICENSE ISSUED BY THE STATE OR COUNTRY TO THE STATE OR COUNTRY; OR

(II) ALLOWED THE LICENSE ISSUED BY THE STATE OR COUNTRY TO EXPIRE OR LAPSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

AN ACT concerning
