

wine societies; authorizing the holder to conduct a national wine exhibition, judge ~~and/or~~, and taste competitive wines; providing that certain wine can only be received from wholesalers; prohibiting the sale of wine; providing for a limitation on the number of days for holding a wine exhibition; authorizing manufacturers, nonresident dealers, suppliers, and wholesalers or their representatives to be judges and ~~make-presentations-at~~ to participate in the wine exhibitions; authorizing certain licensed premises to have wine exhibitions; requiring the permittee to file a certain report with the Comptroller; providing a certain definition; stating the age for the transportation and possession of wine; and generally relating to creating a State wine exhibition permit.
