

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall take effect June 1, 1985 and shall remain in effect until February 1, 1986. On February 1, 1986, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. Section 3 of this Act shall take effect February 1, 1986.

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Dealer's and Vehicle Salesman's Licenses

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
