AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Personalized Registration Plates

FOR the purpose of altering the number of combined letters and numerals permitted for a special, personalized registration plate; providing that the Motor Vehicle Administration shall keep a certain amount of the fee payable with an original application for a special, personalized registration plate; providing that certain funds may not be credited to a certain account; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to altering the number of combined letters and numerals permitted for a special, personalized registration plate.

Article - Transportation Section 13-613 Annotated Code of Maryland (1984 Replacement Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

13-613.

- (a) (1) The owner of any vehicle described in paragraph (2) of this subsection may apply to the Administration for the assignment to that vehicle of a special, personalized registration number.
 - (2) This section applies only as to:
 - (i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;
 - (ii) A Class D (motorcycle) vehicle;
- (iii) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less manufacturer's rated capacity; or
 - (iv) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.
- (b) In addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required by this title, the applicant shall pay an additional annual fee of \$25, payable with the original and each renewal application for special registration under this section.
