

## (B) AWARDS.

NOTICE OF THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR ANY STATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FOR WHICH THE BID AMOUNT WAS REASONABLY EXPECTED TO EXCEED \$25,000 SHALL BE PUBLISHED IN THE MARYLAND REGISTER, WHETHER OR NOT THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE NOTICE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

## (C) WAIVER.

IN AN EMERGENCY, THE HEAD OF THE CONTRACTING AGENCY MAY WAIVE THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION. THE NECESSITY FOR THE WAIVER SHALL BE DOCUMENTED AND PUBLISHED IN THE MARYLAND REGISTER.

## 21-303. NOTICES OF OTHER CONTRACTS PERMITTED.

AT THE OPTION OF THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE DIVISION OF STATE DOCUMENTS, NOTICES OF REQUESTS FOR BIDS ON AND AWARDS OF STATE CONTRACTS OTHER THAN FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS MAY BE PUBLISHED IN THE MARYLAND REGISTER IF:

(1) THE CONTRACTING AGENCY REQUESTS PUBLICATION;

(2) THE VALUE OF THE CONTRACT IS REASONABLY EXPECTED TO EXCEED \$25,000; AND

(3) THE CONTRACTING AGENCY AND THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE DIVISION OF STATE DOCUMENTS CONSIDER PUBLICATION TO BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE STATE.

## 21-401. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.
