CHAPTER 599

(House Bill 245)

AN ACT concerning

Alcohol-Related Driving Offenses - Penalties

FOR the purpose of providing certain mandatory minimum penalties for subsequent convictions of certain alcohol-related driving offenses that occur within a certain period of time after a prior conviction; defining a certain term; providing that penalties imposed under this Act are not subject to suspension or probation; and generally relating to sentencing for certain alcohol-related driving offenses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
