Cards and Drivers' Licenses - Prohibitions

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from duplicating, reproducing, or producing a facsimile of, an age--efmajerity identification card issued by the Motor Vehicle Administration or a driver's license; providing certain exceptions; providing that the Motor Vehicle Administration may apply to a circuit court of this State for certain injunctions; and generally relating to prohibitions of the duplication, reproduction, or production of facsimiles of, age-ef-majerity identification cards or driver's license issued by the Motor Vehicle Administration.

BY adding to

Article - Transportation Section 16-302 Annotated Code of Maryland (1984 Replacement Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

16-302.

- (A) A PERSON MAY NOT DUPLICATE OR REPRODUCE THE FOLLOWING:
- (1) ANY IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE BY THE ADMINISTRATION; OR
 - (2) A DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE.
- (B) A PERSON MAY NOT PRODUCE A FACSIMILE OF AN AGE-OF MAJORITY-CARD IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY THE ADMINISTRATION OR A DRIVER'S LICENSE UNLESS THE DRIVER'S-LICENSE FACSIMILE IS:
 - (1) IN BLACK AND WHITE; OR
- (2) LESS THAN ONE-HALF OR MORE THAN TWICE THE SIZE OF THE AGE-OF-MAJORITY--GARD IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY THE ADMINISTRATION OR DRIVER'S LICENSE.
- (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY APPLY TO A CIRCUIT COURT OF THIS STATE FOR AN INJUNCTION, AS PROVIDED BY THE MARYLAND RULES, TO RESTRAIN A PERSON FROM VIOLATING OR CONTINUING TO VIOLATE ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION.
