(House Bill 734)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Board of Education -
Residency Requirement
PG 404A-85

FOR the purpose of altering certain qualification requirements for a candidate for a position on the Prince George's County Board of Education.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education
Section 3-802(c)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1978 Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

3-802.

(c) (1) A candidate for the County Board shall be a resident of Prince George's County for at least 3 years and a registered voter of the county before the election.

(2) ~~At~~ FROM the time of [their] FILING AS A CANDIDATE FOR election, each [elected member of the County Board shall reside in a different school board district] CANDIDATE FOR THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL RESIDE IN THE SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICT THE CANDIDATE SEEKS TO REPRESENT.

(3) An elected County Board member shall forfeit his office if he:

(i) Fails to reside in the school board district from which he was elected, unless this change is caused by a change in the boundaries of the district; or

(ii) Fails to be a registered voter of the county.

(4) A County Board member may not hold another office of profit in county government during his term.

(5) Each elected member of the County Board shall be nominated by the registered voters of his school board district.
