- (e)--In--1989--the--new-member-shall-represent-the-County-at large:
- (a) In 1986, the member appointed shall be a resident of Legislative District 33;
- (b) In 1987, of the 2 members appointed, 1 shall be a resident of Legislative District 32 and 1 shall be a resident of the County;
- (c) In 1988, the member appointed shall be a resident of the County;
- (d) In 1989, the member appointed shall be a resident of the County; and
- (e) In 1990, of the 2 members appointed, 1 shall be a resident of Legislative District 30 or Legislative District 29A (Anne Arundel Election District 7; Precincts 1 and 2), and 1 shall be a resident of Legislative District 31.

A board member appointed pursuant to this Section who does not maintain the residency requirement shall be replaced as a member.

SECTION-3:--AND-BE-IT-FURTHER--ENACTED;--That--this--Act--is hereby--declared-to-be-an-emergency-measure-and-necessary-for-the immediate-preservation-of-the-public-health-and-safety-and-having been-passed-by-a-yea-and-nay-vote-supported--by--three-fifths--of all--the-members-elected-to-each-of-the-two-Houses-of-the-General Assembly;-the-same--shall--take--effect--from--the--date--of--its passage:
