

(B) (1) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II), A CANDIDATE FOR AN OFFICE SET FORTH IN § 4-101 OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL FILE THE STATEMENT REQUIRED BY THIS TITLE EACH YEAR BEGINNING WITH THE YEAR IN WHICH THE CANDIDATE'S CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY IS FILED AND ENDING WITH THE YEAR OF THE ELECTION.

(II) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE THE FILING OF A STATEMENT COVERING ANY YEAR COVERED IN FULL BY A STATEMENT FILED BY THE CANDIDATE UNDER SUBSECTION (A).

(2) ANY STATEMENT REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION SHALL:

(I) COVER THE CALENDAR YEAR PRECEDING THE YEAR IN WHICH THE STATEMENT IS DUE; AND

(II) BE FILED UNDER OATH OR AFFIRMATION WITH THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS WITH WHICH THE CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY IS FILED.

(3) (I) THE FIRST STATEMENT FILED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE FILED WITH OR PRIOR TO THE FILING OF THE CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY.

(II) IN EACH CALENDAR YEAR SUBSEQUENT TO THE YEAR IN WHICH THE CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY IS FILED, EXCEPT THE YEAR OF THE ELECTION, THE STATEMENT SHALL BE FILED ON OR BEFORE APRIL 30.

(II) IN THE YEAR OF THE ELECTION, THE STATEMENT SHALL BE FILED ON OR BEFORE THE EARLIER OF:

1. APRIL 30; OR

2. THE LAST DAY FOR WITHDRAWAL OF CANDIDACY.

(4) A CANDIDATE WHO FAILS TO FILE A STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, AND WHO IS PROVIDED WRITTEN NOTICE FROM THE BOARD OF THE DEFAULT, SHALL BE DEEMED TO HAVE WITHDRAWN THE CANDIDACY IF THE STATEMENT IS NOT FILED WITHIN 20 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE NOTICE.

(d) (C) The State Administrative Board of Election Laws and the local boards of election supervisors may not accept any certificate of candidacy or certificate of nomination unless a statement in proper form has been filed. Within 30 days of the receipt of a statement by any such board, it shall forward it to the Commission.

(e) (D) All statements filed pursuant to this title shall be maintained by the Commission and shall be made available by the Commission, during normal office hours, for examination and copying by the public, subject, however, to such reasonable fees and administrative procedures as the Commission may establish
