SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

16-206.

(a) (1) The Administration may suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew the license of any resident or the nonresident's privilege to drive of any nonresident on a showing by its records or other sufficient evidence that the applicant or licensee:

[(1)] (I) Has been convicted of moving violations so often as to indicate an intent to disregard the traffic laws and the safety of other persons on the highways;

[(2)] (II) Is an unfit, unsafe, or habitually reckless or negligent driver of a motor vehicle;

[(3)] (III) Has permitted an unlawful or fraudulent use of his license;

[(4)] (IV) Has committed an offense in another state that, if committed in this State, would be grounds for suspension or revocation; or

[(5)] (V) Has knowingly made a false certification of required security in any application for a certificate of title or for the registration of a vehicle.

(2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY SUSPEND A LICENSE TO DRIVE OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO FAILS TO ATTEND:

(I) A DRIVER IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM OR AN ALCOHOL EDUCATION PROGRAM REQUIRED UNDER § 16-212 OF THIS SUBTITLE; OR

(II) A PRIVATE ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM OR AN ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM THAT IS PROVIDED BY A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE UNDER § 16-212 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
