

(a) A Class D beer and light wine license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located. The license authorizes its holder to keep for sale and to sell beer and light wines at retail, at the place described in the license, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere. The license may not be issued for any drugstore. The annual fee for the license is \$60, and shall be payable to the clerk, before any license is issued, for distribution as provided in this article.

(y) (1) In Worcester County, the annual fees for the following types of licenses are:

(i) Six day -- \$250; AND

(ii) Seven day, applied countywide -- [\$275]
\$300.

(2) The hours for sale are as provided in § 106(c).

(3) In Worcester County light wine means any fermented beverage not in excess of 22 percent of alcohol by volume.

19.

(a) A Class B beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located, and the license authorizes its holder to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at retail at any hotel or restaurant at the place described, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere, or as provided in the following subsections. The annual fee for this license is \$750, except as provided, and is payable to the clerk, before any license is issued, for distribution as provided in this article.

(y) (1) In Worcester County, the annual fees for the following types of licenses are:

(i) Six day -- [\$1,000] \$1,250; AND

(ii) Seven day -- [\$1,250] \$1,500.

21.

(a) A Class D beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located. It shall authorize the holder thereof to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at retail at the place therein described, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere. No license shall be issued for any drugstore. The annual fee for the license shall be \$500, except as hereinafter provided, and shall be payable to the clerk before any license is issued, for distribution as hereinafter provided.
