(House Bill 1352)

AN ACT concerning

Income Tax - Deductions - Official Vehicles

FOR the purpose of providing members of State, county, or local police forces or fire departments with a deduction for State income tax purposes, for any amount included in federal income for use of certain employer-provided vehicles.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 81 - Revenue and Taxes

- (c) There shall be subtracted from federal adjusted gross income:
- (15) (i) 1. Expenses incurred of up to \$1,000 for any one taxable year by employers in providing readers for blind employees of that employer; and
- 2. Expenses incurred of up to \$1,000 for any one taxable year by blind employees in obtaining a reader for use in the employment of the blind employee.
- (ii) In this paragraph, "blind" means permanent impairment of both eyes of the following status: central visual acuity of 20/200 or less in the better eye, with corrective
