

6-104. CONTRACTS FOR THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY.

(A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISIONS OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE COUNTY MAY GRANT AND CONVEY ANY COUNTY INTEREST IN REAL PROPERTY OTHER THAN BY FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURES IF THE COMMISSIONERS DETERMINE THAT IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY TO DO SO, PROVIDED THAT:

(1) THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE TRANSFER IS NOT LESS THAN THE HIGHEST OF 2 INDEPENDENT APPRAISALS; AND

(2) THE COMMISSIONERS SET OUT ON THE RECORD THE REASONS FOR THEIR DETERMINATION.

(B) BEFORE CONVEYING ANY PROPERTY INTEREST UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSIONERS SHALL PUBLISH A NOTICE DESCRIBING THE PROPERTY AND THE SALE FOR AT LEAST 2 CONSECUTIVE WEEKS IN AT LEAST 2 COUNTY NEWSPAPERS.

TITLE 9. BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

SUBTITLE 1. BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS AND SUPERVISORS.

9-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "ELECTRICIAN" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ENGAGES IN THE BUSINESS OF ELECTRICIAN.

(C) "BUSINESS OF ELECTRICIAN" MEANS THE BUSINESS OF INSTALLING, ERECTING, OR REPAIRING, OR CONTRACTING TO INSTALL, ERECT, OR REPAIR ELECTRIC WIRES OR CONDUCTORS, TO BE USED FOR THE TRANSMISSION OF ELECTRIC CURRENT FOR ELECTRIC LIGHT, HEAT, OR POWER PURPOSES, OR MOULDINGS, DUCTS, RACEWAYS, OR CONDUITS FOR THE RECEPTION OR PROTECTION OF THOSE WIRES OR CONDUCTORS, OR ANY ELECTRICAL MACHINERY, APPARATUS, DEVICES, OR FIXTURES TO BE USED FOR ELECTRIC LIGHT, HEAT, OR POWER PURPOSES.

(D) "MASTER ELECTRICIAN" MEANS AN ELECTRICIAN WHO IS AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD AND HOLDS A CLASS OF LICENSE THAT INDICATES THE HOLDER HAS MET THE MOST STRINGENT REQUIREMENTS SET BY THE BOARD.

9-102. BOARD; APPOINTMENT, TENURE.

(A) A 3 MEMBER BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS AND SUPERVISORS FOR CALVERT COUNTY IS CREATED FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXAMINING THE QUALIFICATIONS AND CAPABILITIES OF ALL PERSONS WHO
