

ARE ENGAGED OR DESIRE TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF ELECTRICIAN AS DEFINED IN THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE FROM A LIST OF 5 PERSONS SUBMITTED BY THE CALVERT COUNTY ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION, OR, IF THIS ASSOCIATION DOES NOT EXIST, BY THE STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE.

(C) A MEMBER SHALL SERVE FOR A TERM OF 2 YEARS.

(D) ALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE MASTER ELECTRICIANS WHO HAVE RESIDED AND BEEN ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF ELECTRICIAN IN CALVERT COUNTY FOR A PERIOD OF 3 YEARS.

(E) SHOULD ANY VACANCY OCCUR FROM ANY CAUSE DURING THE TERM OF ANY BOARD, THE GOVERNOR SHALL FILL THE VACANCY FOR THE UNEXPIRED PORTION OF THE TERM. THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE ANY MEMBER OF THE BOARD FOR INCOMPETENCY OR IMPROPER CONDUCT UPON SATISFACTORY PRESENTATION OF EVIDENCE OF THAT CONDITION.

9-103. SAME; OATH, ORGANIZATION.

THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL TAKE AND SUBSCRIBE THE OATH REQUIRED BY OTHER STATE OFFICERS. THEY SHALL ELECT OUT OF THEIR NUMBER A PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, AND SECRETARY-TREASURER, AND ADOPT WHATEVER REGULATIONS AND BYLAWS FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS OF THE BOARD THEY DEEM EXPEDIENT.

9-104. SAME; COMPENSATION.

THE COUNTY SHALL PAY THE EXPENSES OF THE BOARD THAT ARE APPROVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND SHALL PAY EACH MEMBER \$50 FOR EACH MEETING OF THE BOARD THE MEMBER ATTENDS. THE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF THE BOARD MAY NOT BE PAID OUT OF THE FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY OR BECOME A CHARGE AGAINST THE STATE.

9-105. SAME; MEETINGS, REGULATIONS.

(A) THE BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH IN PRINCE FREDERICK AND SHALL HOLD SPECIAL MEETINGS AS FREQUENTLY AS THE PROPER AND EFFICIENT DISCHARGE OF ITS BUSINESS REQUIRES.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS ON THE CLASSES OF LICENSES, THE SETTING OF FEES, THE EXAMINATION OF APPLICANTS, AND THE REGULATION OF THE BUSINESS OF ELECTRICIAN IN CALVERT COUNTY. THE RULES OF THE BOARD SHALL PROVIDE FOR TIMELY NOTICE OF EXAMINATIONS TO ALL LICENSE APPLICANTS. PROPOSED REGULATIONS SHALL BE PUBLISHED IN AT LEAST 2 COUNTY NEWSPAPERS FOR 2 CONSECUTIVE WEEKS. THE COMMISSIONERS SHALL PROVIDE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS AND SHALL PUBLISH NOTICE OF THE HEARING WITH THE PROPOSED REGULATIONS. THE REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AS PROVIDED BY THE BOARD, EXCEPT FOR REGULATIONS SETTING THE AMOUNT OF FEES, WHICH SHALL BE EFFECTIVE UPON APPROVAL BY THE COMMISSIONERS.
