

EXCEPT FOR MINOR ELECTRICAL REPAIRS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF ESTABLISHED PLANTS, A PERSON OTHER THAN A MASTER ELECTRICIAN MAY ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF ELECTRICIAN ONLY IF THAT PERSON WORKS UNDER THE DIRECTION AND SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED MASTER ELECTRICIAN, WHO SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL WORK DONE.

9-111. LICENSE RENEWALS.

(A) ALL LICENSES AND RENEWALS OF LICENSES EXPIRE ON MAY 1 IN EACH YEAR.

(B) IF A LICENSEE APPLIES TO THE BOARD WITHIN 3 MONTHS PRECEDING EXPIRATION AND PAYS THE RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE WITHOUT REEXAMINATION OF THE APPLICANT.

9-112. SUSPENSION; REVOCATION.

THE BOARD MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE FOR PROPER CAUSE ANY LICENSE OR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE AFTER A FULL HEARING OF ALL PARTIES IN INTEREST.

9-113. INSURANCE REQUIRED.

A LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED OR RENEWED ONLY IF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE PROVES TO THE BOARD THAT THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE IS INSURED IN THE AMOUNT OF AT LEAST \$100,000 FOR GENERAL LIABILITY AND AT LEAST \$300,000 FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE. A LICENSE IS REVOKED AUTOMATICALLY IF THE INSURANCE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IS NO LONGER IN EFFECT.

9-114. DISPLAY OF LICENSE.

A LICENSEE SHALL DISPLAY A CURRENT LICENSE OR RENEWAL IN A CONSPICUOUS AREA IN THE PLACE OF BUSINESS OF THE LICENSEE.

9-115. LICENSES NONTRANSFERABLE.

A LICENSE OR LICENSE RENEWAL GRANTED OR ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT BE ASSIGNED OR TRANSFERRED, AND EVERY LICENSE AND LICENSE RENEWAL SHALL SPECIFY THE NAME OF THE PERSON TO WHOM IT IS ISSUED.

9-116. INSPECTORS.

THE COUNTY SHALL EMPLOY 1 OR MORE ELECTRICAL INSPECTORS WHO SHALL BE PAID BY THE COUNTY AND WHO SHALL INSPECT ELECTRICAL WORK IN THE COUNTY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD. ONLY THE COUNTY MAY SET FEES FOR PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS OF ELECTRICAL WORK.

9-117. CUT-IN CERTIFICATES.
