

(5) The fees shall be paid to the clerk for the use of the county before the license is issued.

(6) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY NOT REQUIRE THE PUBLICATION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A SPECIAL TEMPORARY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE AS A PREREQUISITE TO THE GRANTING OF SUCH A LICENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
