- (L) A PERSON WHO ENGAGES IN A TRANSIENT BUSINESS IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$2,500 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR, OR BOTH.
- (M) LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL FROM THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, AND THE STATE MAY ENFORCE COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

CHAPTER 723

(Senate Bill 36)

AN ACT concerning

Attorney's Liens

FOR the purpose of providing that an attorney has a lien on certain actions of the attorney's client and certain judgments entered in favor of the attorney's client; providing that an attorney's lien extends to attorney's fees and compensation specially agreed on er-te-the-reasemable value---ef---the--attorney's---services under certain circumstances; providing for the priority of an attorney's lien, with exceptions; and generally providing for an attorney's lien on certain actions of the attorney's client and on certain judgments entered in favor of the attorney's client.

BY adding to

Article 10 - Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact Section 46 Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1984 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 10 - Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact

(A) AN ATTORNEY HAS A LIEN ON:
