

(i) -- A DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCEDURES AND METHODS TO BE USED BY THE UNIT TO REVIEW AND EVALUATE ITS EXISTING REGULATIONS WITHIN THE DEADLINE ESTABLISHED BY THE EXECUTIVE ORDER;

(ii) -- THE NAME OF THE INDIVIDUAL IN THE UNIT WHO SHALL BE THE COORDINATOR OF THE EVALUATION AND THE LIAISON TO THE COMMITTEE; AND

(iii) -- THE SCHEDULE FOR REVIEW THE UNIT WILL FOLLOW IN ORDER THAT ITS EVALUATION REPORT IS COMPLETED ON OR BEFORE THE DEADLINE ESTABLISHED IN THE EXECUTIVE ORDER.

(3) -- THE COMMITTEE MAY SUBMIT TO THE UNIT, IN WRITING, ANY RECOMMENDED CHANGES TO THE WORK PLAN WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE WORK PLAN BY THE COMMITTEE.

(4) -- (i) -- IF THE COMMITTEE DOES NOT APPROVE THE WORK PLAN OR ANY PART OF THE WORK PLAN, THE COMMITTEE SHALL MEET WITH THE HEAD OF THE UNIT.

(ii) -- THE HEAD OF THE UNIT AND THE COMMITTEE SHALL ATTEMPT TO RESOLVE ANY DISAGREEMENTS WITHIN 10 DAYS.

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(A) -- (1) -- EACH UNIT SHALL COMPLETE AN EVALUATION REPORT ON OR BEFORE THE DEADLINE ESTABLISHED BY THE EXECUTIVE ORDER.

(2) -- THE EVALUATION REPORT MAY CONTAIN:

(i) -- PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING REGULATIONS;

(ii) -- ANY PROPOSED REPEAL OF OBSOLETE EXISTING REGULATIONS; AND

(iii) -- ANY PROPOSED REORGANIZATION OF REGULATIONS THE UNIT DETERMINES IS APPROPRIATE THAT IS APPROVED BY THE DIVISION OF STATE DOCUMENTS.

(3) -- AN EVALUATION REPORT SHALL CONTAIN:

(i) -- ANY IMPACT STATEMENTS REQUIRED BY LAW AND A STATEMENT OF IMPACT ON THE PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH, OR WELFARE FOR EACH:

1. -- PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO EXISTING REGULATIONS; AND

2. -- PROPOSED REPEAL OF OBSOLETE REGULATIONS; AND

(ii) -- THE APPROVAL OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, AS TO THE LEGALITY OF THE EVALUATION REPORT.
