

(B) - (1) -- ON COMPLETION OF ITS EVALUATION REPORT, -- A -- UNIT SHALL:

(i) -- PROVIDE A COPY TO THE COMMITTEE;

(ii) -- PROVIDE SUFFICIENT COPIES TO THE STATE LIBRARY RESOURCE CENTER FOR DISTRIBUTION TO DESIGNATED DEPOSITORY LIBRARIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE; AND

(iii) -- PUBLISH A NOTICE IN THE MARYLAND REGISTER THAT THE EVALUATION REPORT IS AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION AND COMMENT FOR 60 DAYS.

(2) -- THE UNIT MAY HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE EVALUATION REPORT AT THE DISCRETION OF THE HEAD OF THE UNIT.

(C) - (1) -- THE COMMITTEE SHALL REVIEW THE EVALUATION REPORT.

(2) -- DURING THE COMMITTEE REVIEW, THE COMMITTEE SHALL SOLICIT PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE EVALUATION IN THE FORM OF:

(i) -- WRITTEN COMMENTS; AND

(ii) -- TESTIMONY AT PUBLIC HEARINGS HELD BY THE COMMITTEE.

(D) - (1) -- DURING THE 60-DAY REVIEW PERIOD UNDER SUBSECTION (B) (1) OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMITTEE MAY SUBMIT TO THE UNIT COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGE OF THE UNIT'S EVALUATION REPORT.

(2) -- WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE END OF THE 60-DAY REVIEW PERIOD, THE UNIT SHALL NOTIFY THE COMMITTEE OF THE UNIT'S AGREEMENT OR DISAGREEMENT WITH THE COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDATIONS AND SHALL ATTEMPT TO RESOLVE ANY DISAGREEMENTS.

§ 10-136.

(A) - (1) -- IF A UNIT IS IN DISAGREEMENT WITH A COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION, WITHIN 30 DAYS OF AN ATTEMPT TO RESOLVE UNDER § 10-135 (C) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE UNIT SHALL SUBMIT THE EVALUATION REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR WITH AN EXPLANATION OF THE DISAGREEMENT AND A STATEMENT OF JUSTIFICATION FOR THE UNIT'S POSITION.

(2) -- WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE JUSTIFICATION AND AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL:

(i) -- INSTRUCT THE UNIT TO MODIFY THE EVALUATION REPORT; OR

(ii) -- APPROVE THE EVALUATION REPORT AS PROPOSED BY THE UNIT.
