SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

(Senate Bill 346)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Montgomery County Librarians

FOR the purpose of repealing-a-certain-obselete-reference-to-the Washington-Gounty-Free-bibrary; and altering by a certain amount the State's rate of contribution to the retirement and pension system for Montgomery County library employees; altering the procedures for certification of the amounts due and payable under the pension system for teachers; and generally relating to the amount of the State's rate of contribution to the retirement and pension system for teachers.
