(B) THE CONSUMER MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

- (1) SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;
- (2) MAY NOT BE OR EVER HAVE BEEN A PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR OR IN TRAINING TO BECOME A PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR;
- (3) MAY NOT HAVE A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER WHO IS A PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR OR IN TRAINING TO BECOME A PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR;
- (4) MAY NOT PARTICIPATE OR EVER HAVE PARTICIPATED IN A COMMERCIAL OR PROFESSIONAL FIELD RELATED TO PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING;
- (5) MAY NOT HAVE A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER WHO PARTICIPATES IN A COMMERCIAL OR PROFESSIONAL FIELD RELATED TO PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING; AND
- (6) MAY NOT HAVE HAD WITHIN 2 YEARS BEFORE APPOINTMENT A SUBSTANTIAL FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A PERSON REGULATED BY THE BOARD.
