

(A) A CERTIFICATE EXPIRES ON THE DATE SET BY THE BOARD, UNLESS THE CERTIFICATE IS RENEWED FOR AN ADDITIONAL TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION. A LICENSE MAY NOT BE RENEWED FOR A TERM LONGER THAN 2 YEARS.

(B) AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE A CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE BOARD SHALL SEND TO THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT STATES:

(1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT CERTIFICATE EXPIRES;

(2) THE DATE BY WHICH THE RENEWAL APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE BOARD FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES; AND

(3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.

(C) BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW THE CERTIFICATE FOR AN ADDITIONAL 2-YEAR TERM, IF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER:

(1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE CERTIFIED;

(2) PAYS TO THE BOARD THE RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE BOARD; AND

(3) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD:

(I) A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT IT REQUIRES; AND

(II) SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH ANY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS SET UNDER THIS SECTION FOR CERTIFICATE RENEWAL.

(D) THE BOARD SHALL RENEW THE CERTIFICATE OF EACH CERTIFICATE HOLDER WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

15.5-310.

(A) (1) THE BOARD SHALL PLACE A CERTIFICATE ON INACTIVE STATUS, IF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER SUBMITS TO THE BOARD:

(I) AN APPLICATION FOR INACTIVE STATUS ON THE FORM REQUIRED BY THE BOARD; AND

(II) THE INACTIVE STATUS FEE SET BY THE BOARD.

(2) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A CERTIFICATE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ON INACTIVE STATUS IF THE INDIVIDUAL COMPLIES WITH THE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS THAT EXISTED WHEN THE INDIVIDUAL WAS PLACED ON INACTIVE STATUS.
