- (A) A CERTIFICATE EXPIRES ON THE DATE SET BY THE BOARD, UNLESS THE CERTIFICATE IS RENEWED FOR AN ADDITIONAL TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION. A LICENSE MAY NOT BE RENEWED FOR A TERM LONGER THAN 2 YEARS.
- (B) AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE A CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE BOARD SHALL SEND TO THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT STATES:
- (1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT CERTIFICATE EXPIRES;
- (2) THE DATE BY WHICH THE RENEWAL APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE BOARD FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES; AND
 - (3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.
- (C) BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW THE CERTIFICATE FOR AN ADDITIONAL 2-YEAR TERM, IF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER:
 - (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE CERTIFIED;
- (2) PAYS TO THE BOARD THE RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE BOARD; AND
 - (3) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD:
- (I) A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT IT REQUIRES; AND
- (II) SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH ANY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS SET UNDER THIS SECTION FOR CERTIFICATE RENEWAL.
- (D) THE BOARD SHALL RENEW THE CERTIFICATE OF EACH CERTIFICATE HOLDER WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

 15.5-310.
- (A) (1) THE BOARD SHALL PLACE A CERTIFICATE ON INACTIVE STATUS, IF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER SUBMITS TO THE BOARD:
- (I) AN APPLICATION FOR INACTIVE STATUS ON THE FORM REQUIRED BY THE BOARD; AND
 - (II) THE INACTIVE STATUS FEE SET BY THE BOARD.
- (2) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A CERTIFICATE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ON INACTIVE STATUS IF THE INDIVIDUAL COMPLIES WITH THE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS THAT EXISTED WHEN THE INDIVIDUAL WAS PLACED ON INACTIVE STATUS.
