AN ACT concerning

Procurement - Architectural and Engineering Services - Award of Contracts

the purpose of requiring certain State agencies to make FOR recommendations for the award of contracts for architectural and engineering services on the basis of negotiation; certain procedures for negotiation among establishing competing firms; authorizing delegation of the negotiation process to certain departments; providing that certain documents be available for public review; providing that certain actions be taken at public meetings; providing for the effective date of this Act; altering the amount of a contract to procure architectural or engineering services to which certain provisions of the Procurement Article apply; altering the amount of a contract to procure architectural or engineering services which shall be subject to recommendation of award by the General Selection Board and a requirement for a truth-in-negotiation certificate; providing for a certain contingency; and generally the award of architectural and engineering services contracts.
