CHAPTER 755

(House Bill 390)

AN ACT concerning

Election Law - Contested Elections

FOR the purpose of creating a uniform procedure under which a registered voter may seek judicial relief from certain acts or omissions relating to an election; specifying the venue, time limits, and general procedures for proceedings brought under this Act; providing certain remedies that may be ordered by the court; repealing certain existing provisions relating to contested elections; and generally relating to the conduct of, and challenges to, elections subject to the provisions of the State Election Code.
