

(3) The Department shall waive annual license fees for certain persons, as follows:

(i) Persons WHO ARE STATE RESIDENTS under 14 and over 64 years of age to harvest crabs by trotline, trap, pound, scrape, or dip net;

(ii) Persons WHO ARE STATE RESIDENTS over 64 years of age to harvest oysters by handtong or handscape in authorized areas;

(iii) Persons WHO ARE STATE RESIDENTS over 64 years of age to harvest finfish for commercial purposes with a single gill net up to 200 yards in length; AND

(iv) Persons WHO ARE STATE RESIDENTS under 14 and over 64 years of age for finfish and crab harvesting for personal consumption pursuant to §§ 4-709 and 4-804(c); AND

(4) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS PARAGRAPH, A PERSON MAY NOT TRANSFER OR LOAN A LICENSE THAT IS ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(II) IF A LICENSEE IS UNABLE TO FISH DUE TO ILLNESS AND THE NATURAL RESOURCES POLICE APPROVES A TRANSFER OF A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A LICENSEE MAY TRANSFER THE LICENSE FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 DAYS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
