- (3) The Department shall waive annual license fees for certain persons, as follows:
- (i) Persons WHO ARE STATE RESIDENTS under 14 and over 64 years of age to harvest crabs by trotline, trap, pound, scrape, or dip net;
- (ii) Persons WHO ARE STATE RESIDENTS over 64 years of age to harvest oysters by handtong or handscrape in authorized areas;
- (iii) Persons WHO ARE STATE RESIDENTS over 64 years of age to harvest finfish for commercial purposes with a single gill net up to 200 yards in length; AND
- (iv) Persons WHO ARE STATE RESIDENTS under 14 and over 64 years of age for finfish and crab harvesting for personal consumption pursuant to §§ 4-709 and 4-804(c);-AND
- (V)--PERSONS--WHO-ARE-NOT-RESIDENTS-OF-THE-STATE TO-BUY,-SELL,-PROCESS,-TRANSPORT,-EXPORT,-OR--OTHERWISE--DEAL--IN FISH--CAUCHT-IN-TIDAL-WATERS,-IF-THE-PERSONS-ONLY-BUY-FISH-IN-THE STATE-BUT-DOES-NOT-SELL-THE-FISH-IN-THE-STATE.
- (4) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS PARAGRAPH, A PERSON MAY NOT TRANSFER OR LOAN A LICENSE THAT IS ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- (II) IF A LICENSEE IS UNABLE TO FISH DUE TO ILLNESS AND THE NATURAL RESOURCES POLICE APPROVES A TRANSFER OF A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A LICENSEE MAY TRANSFER THE LICENSE FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 DAYS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
