SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 149 and 155(1) of Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

149.

(A) (1) THERE IS A BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS IN FREDERICK COUNTY.

(2) THE BOARD CONSISTS OF 3 MEMBERS.

(3) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

(4) TO QUALIFY FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE BOARD, A PERSON:

(I) SHALL BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER AND INTEGRITY;

(II) SHALL REASONABLY REFLECT THE CITIZENRY OF THE COUNTY; AND
