- (6) In Worcester County a fee to the attorney representing the county treasurer, up to thirty-five dollars (\$35) for each property, to be approved by the county treasurer and by the Board of County Commissioners.
- (7) In Baltimore City a fee not to exceed \$5 for the mailing of statements and notices.
- (8) A reasonable fee not to exceed \$150 for examinations of title prior to the mailing of statements and notices.

- (b) The rate of redemption is 6 percent per annum except as follows:
- (1) In Anne Arundel County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by ordinance of the County Council;
- (2) In Baltimore City the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by ordinance of the City Council;
- (3) In Baltimore County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by ordinance of the County Council;
- (4) In Calvert County the rate is 10 percent per annum or as fixed by the County Commissioners;
- (5) In Frederick County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by the County Commissioners;
- (6) In Harford County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council;
- (7) In Howard County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council;
- (8) In Kent County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by the County Commissioners;
- (9) In Montgomery County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council;
- (10) In Prince George's County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council; [and]
- (11) IN QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY THE RATE IS 6 PERCENT PER ANNUM OR AS FIXED BY RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; AND
- [(11)] (12) In Somerset, Wicomico, and Worcester counties the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by the county commissioners or by resolution of the county council.
