SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 27A, 28, 130, 131, 132, 133, 134, 135, 136, 137, 138, and 163 of Article 73B - Pensions of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 73B - Pensions

MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS

163.

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "EMPLOYEE", AS USED IN THIS SUBTITLE, MEANS THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WHO ARE ELIGIBLE TO AND WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND OR THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND.

(C) "LEGISLATIVE BODY" MEANS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, CITY COUNCIL, TOWN COUNCIL, PRESIDENT AND COMMISSIONERS, BURGESS AND COMMISSIONERS (OR BY WHATEVER OTHER NAME THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF ANY INCORPORATED TOWN, CITY, OR MUNICIPALITY MAY BE KNOWN), AND THE BOARD OR COMMISSION HAVING AUTHORITY OR CONTROL OVER ANY OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE, INCLUDING THE BOARD OR GOVERNING BODY OF ANY PUBLIC LIBRARY ASSOCIATION OR ORGANIZATION AND ANY FIRE DEPARTMENT RECEIVING PART OR ALL OF ITS FUNDS FROM OR THROUGH ANY COUNTY, INCORPORATED TOWN, OR MUNICIPALITY, OR SPECIAL TAXING AREA, OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE.
