WHEREAS, There is a need to protect the groundwater supplies of Maryland from contamination and depletion; and

WHEREAS, There needs to be a comprehensive approach to the development and implementation of a groundwater protection management strategy; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Governor-is-requested:

(1)--To-designate-the-Department-of-Health-and--Mental Hygiene---as--the--lead--agency--in--the--State--for--developing; coordinating;--and--planning--groundwater--protection---policies; programs;-and-strategies-in-the-State;

(2)--Te--require the Departments of Agriculture and Natural Resources and any other appropriate units of State government to work cooperatively with the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene which is the lead agency for groundwater protection in the State, in the development, coordination, and planning of groundwater protection policies, programs, and strategies in the State; and be it further
