

RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Governor and Legislative Policy Committee are requested to appoint a task force to recommend ways in which to control the spread of rabies in Maryland; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force be composed of:

- (1) 2 Senators appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (2) 2 Delegates appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- (3) 2 members of the Department of Natural Resources appointed by the Governor;
- (4) 2 members of the Department of Agriculture appointed by the Governor; and
- (5) 2 members of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene appointed by the Governor; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Department of Natural Resources provide the necessary staff support for this task force; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force report its findings to the Governor and the General Assembly as soon as possible, but no later than October 15, 1985; and be it further
