- (2) THE BUREAU SHALL PREPARE AND SUBMIT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON JANUARY 1, 1990 A SUMMARY REPORT ON THE EFFECTIVENESS OF STEEP SLOPE MINING IN THIS STATE.
- SLOPES OF 20 DEGREES OR MORE FROM THE HORIZONTAL IF IT FINDS THAT ANY OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE OR REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER AUTHORITY OF THIS SUBTITLE ARE NOT MET, INCLUDING A FINDING THAT ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ARE TRUE:
- (I) THE PROPOSED MINING POSES A LIKELIHOOD OF HARM TO ANY PERSON OR PROPERTY;
- (II) DRAINAGE AND STORMWATER RUNOFF COULD NOT BE ADEQUATELY MANAGED;
- AFFECT THE QUALITY OF THE WATER SUPPLY OR OF OTHER WATERS OF THE STATE;
- (IV) THERE IS SLOPE INSTABILITY AT THE SITE OF THE PROPOSED MINING WHICH COULD NOT BE ADEQUATELY CONTROLLED;
- (V) SOIL EROSION COULD NOT BE ADEQUATELY CONTROLLED; OR
- ABILITY TO IMPLEMENT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE PERMIT AND MINING AND RECLAMATION PLAN OR HAS A HISTORY OF FAILING TO COMPLY WITH LAWFUL REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE TO SURFACE MINING.
- (4) IN ADDITION TO THE OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE AN OPERATOR OF STRIP MINING ON ANY SLOPE TO COMPLY WITH:
- (I) A MORE DETAILED REVIEW OF ENGINEERING PLANS; AND
- (II) A HIGHER FREQUENCY OF INSPECTIONS BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- (j) (K) If the Director-of-the-Bureau DEPARTMENT does not approve either the application for a permit or any amended application, he promptly shall notify the operator by registered or certified mail setting forth his reasons for the disapproval. The operator then may take the steps required to have the Bureau's DEPARTMENT'S objections removed.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
