In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 571.

This bill repeals the commercial hunting guide license designation and replaces it with a master hunting guide license.

Senate Bill 89, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 28, 1985, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 571.
