

House Bill No. 949

AN ACT concerning

Veterans Cemeteries - Grave Liners

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Veterans Commission to provide, without charge, grave liners for certain burial plots not to exceed a certain amount.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - State Government  
Section 9-913(h)  
Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

9-913.

(h) (1) In a plot that is allotted to a veteran, the Commission shall bury:

[(1)] (I) the veteran; and

[(2)] (II) any member of the immediate family of the veteran if the family member can be buried in a space above or below the veteran.

(2) WITH EACH PLOT, THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE, WITHOUT CHARGE, 1 GRAVE LINER NOT TO EXCEED \$55 IN COST.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
