SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (c) (1) The Commission consists of [11] 13 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. Of the members:
- (i) Each shall be qualified to deal with the matters within the authority of the Commission;
- (ii) [Five] SIX shall be volunteer emergency services personnel or instructors;
- (iii) Three shall be emergency services instructors who are career personnel representing the academies;
- (iv) [Two] THREE shall be career emergency services personnel who are not instructors; and
- $% \left(v\right) =\left\{ v\right\} =\left\{ v\right\}$ (v) One shall be a member of the general public.
- (d) (4) A quorum consists of [six] SEVEN members, one of whom shall be the Chairman or Vice-Chairman.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the two members of the Fire Rescue and Training Commission appointed pursuant to the provisions of this Act may not be from jurisdictions represented on the Commission as of June 30, 1985.
- SECTION -2-3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
