

[(ii)] (III) the Secretary of Natural Resources or a designee; and

[(iii)] (IV) the Secretary of State Planning or a designee.

(b) (1) The term of [an appointed member] A MEMBER APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION is 4 years.

(2) At the end of a term, [an appointed member] A MEMBER APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(3) A member who is appointed UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(C) (1) THE COMMISSION MAY ESTABLISH AND ABOLISH NONVOTING MEMBERSHIPS.

(2) A NONVOTING MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COMMISSION FOR A TERM SET BY THE COMMISSION.

(A) From among its VOTING members, the Commission shall elect a chairman.

(B) FROM AMONG ITS VOTING MEMBERS, THE COMMISSION MAY ELECT A VICE CHAIRMAN AND ANY OTHER OFFICERS IT REQUIRES.

(C) THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND THEIR TERMS OF OFFICE SHALL BE AS THE COMMISSION DETERMINES.

In addition to its other powers and duties, the Commission shall:

(1) [annually] review the operation of [appropriate] units of [the] State AND LOCAL government [and of local governments] THAT HAVE RESPONSIBILITY FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PLAN;

(2) provide a clearinghouse for information on the Patuxent River [Watershed] AND ITS WATERSHED; AND

(3) review and comment on plans and reports RELATED TO THE PATUXENT RIVER AND ITS WATERSHED[;

(4) conduct public hearings and public forums on the policy plan for the Patuxent River Watershed;
