(C) ANY PERSON WHO IS AGGRIEVED BY A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY RECOVER ACTUAL AND PUNITIVE DAMAGES, INCLUDING REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES, FROM THE PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

4-1201.

- (a) Any person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor. Unless another penalty is specifically provided elsewhere in this title, the person, upon conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500, or imprisonment not exceeding three months, or both, with costs imposed in the discretion of the court.
- (b) Unless another penalty is specifically provided elsewhere in this title, any person found guilty of a second or subsequent violation of any provision of this title is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000, or imprisonment not exceeding one year, or both, with costs imposed in the discretion of the court. For the purpose of this subsection, a second or subsequent violation is one which has occurred within two years of any prior violation of this title.
- (c) In addition to any administrative penalty provided in this title, violation of any rule or regulation adopted by any unit within the Department pursuant to the provisions of this title is a misdemeanor and is punishable as provided in subsections (a) and (b) OF THIS SECTION.

10-422.

- (A) A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE PARTICIPATION OF ANY INDIVIDUAL IN A LAWFUL ACTIVITY UNDER THIS SUBTITLE CONCERNING:
  - (1) THE HUNTING OF ANY GAME BIRDS OR MAMMALS; OR
  - (2) AN OPEN SEASON TO HUNT GAME BIRDS OR MAMMALS.
- (B) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE SECRETARY, OR ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO INTENDS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE AFFECTED LAWFUL ACTIVITY UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY OBTAIN AN INJUNCTION AGAINST A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- (C) ANY PERSON WHO IS AGGRIEVED BY A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY RECOVER. ACTUAL AND PUNITIVE DAMAGES, INCLUDING REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES, FROM THE PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

10-1101.

(b) Any person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor. Unless another penalty is specifically provided elsewhere in this title, the person, upon conviction, is
