(b) In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board shall:

(1) Keep a record that includes:

(i) The name and place of business OR HOME ADDRESS of each licensed pharmacist; and

(ii) The facts concerning the issuance of that pharmacist's license; and

(2) Prepare and deliver to the Governor, the Secretary, and the Maryland Pharmaceutical Association an annual report that:

(i) Summarizes the condition of pharmacy in this State;

(ii) Includes a record of the proceedings of the Board; and

(iii) Lists each pharmacist who currently is licensed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1610.

This bill repeals the requirement that the Maryland Transportation Authority construct, operate and maintain a bridge across the Choptank River near Cambridge as a toll facility project. It also requires the new State Highway Administration bridge in this vicinity to be named the Senator Frederick C. Malkus, Jr. Bridge.
