Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1690.

This bill would permit the establishment of interest bearing escrow accounts for retained funds associated with road construction and reconstruction contracts administered by the Department of Transportation. These funds, together with accrued earnings, would be paid to the contractor at the time of final payment. The bill has a delayed effective date of July 1, 1986 and would terminate with no further action by the General Assembly on June 30, 1988.
