Senate Bill No. 12

AN ACT concerning

Savings and Loan Associations - Special Counsel

FOR the purpose of establishing an Office of Special Counsel as an independent unit in the Executive Department; providing for the appointment and qualifications of the Special Counsel; providing for the salary and staff of the Special Counsel; providing for exceptions from the State procurement laws; requiring the Special Counsel to utilize the services and personnel of certain agencies and requiring certain agencies to cooperate with the Special Counsel; providing for the duties, powers, and responsibilities of the Special Counsel; requiring the Special Counsel to make certain investigations and reports; generally relating to savings and loan associations and the establishment, powers, and duties of the Office of Special Counsel; making-this-Aet-an emergency-measure; and specifying the termination of this Act.
