WHEREAS, The appointment of an--Investigator a Special Counsel, not connected with State Government, to conduct such a broad and comprehensive investigation would maximize public confidence in the investigation; and

WHEREAS, It is important not to delay or hinder any investigation currently under way and coordinated with federal prosecutors; and

WHEREAS, It is important to establish an office for a limited period of time with the proper special powers to carry out its investigation of all aspects of the savings and loan association crisis in a thorough and expeditious manner; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT. ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

SUBTITLE 12. SPECIAL COUNSEL

9-1201.

- (A) THERE IS AN OFFICE OF SPECIAL COUNSEL.
- (B) THE OFFICE OF SPECIAL COUNSEL IS AN INDEPENDENT UNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT AND MAY NOT, EXCEPT BY STATUTE, BE MADE A PART OF ANY DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY.
- (C) THE OFFICE OF SPECIAL COUNSEL IS ESTABLISHED FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSES SET FORTH UNDER SECTION 9-1204 OF THIS SUBTITLE. 9-1202.
- (A) (1) THE SPECIAL COUNSEL SHALL BE APPOINTED ON OR BEFORE \$U5Y-17-1985 JUNE 15, 1985 BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE, AND SHALL ASSUME THE DUTIES OF HIS OFFICE BY JULY 1, 1985.
- THE GOVERNOR FOR MISCONDUCT IN OFFICE, PERSISTENT FAILURE TO PERFORM THE DUTIES OF HIS OFFICE, OR CONDUCT PREJUDICIAL TO THE PROPER ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE.
  - (B)--A-PERSON-IS-NOT-ELIGIBLE-TO-BE-SPECIAL-COUNSEL:
