RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF CECILTON ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE 11E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND, SECTION 13 OF ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND 1957 EDITION, 1981 REPLACEMENT VOLUME, TITLED "CORPORATIONS-MUNICIPAL" TO ADD A NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS "SECTION 808" OF THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF CECILTON AS AMENDED, SAID RESOLUTION CONSTITUTES AN AMENDMENT TO THE MUNICIPAL CHARTER OF THE BODY POLITIC AND CORPORATE KNOWN AS "THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF CECILTON".
