A Resolution of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Edmonston, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article XI-E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland and Sections XII and XIII of Article 23-A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1981 Repl. Vol.) to amend Section 16 of the Charter of the Town of Edmonston to change the maximum permissible tax rate from fifty cents (\$0.50) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed property value to seventy-five cents (\$0.75) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed property value.
