Chapter 7

Laws of Montgomery County, 1985

AN ACT to amend Section 19A-4, title "Definitions" of Article I, title "General Provisions" of Chapter 19A, title "Ethics" of the Montgomery County Code 1972, as amended, for the purpose of deleting various agencies from the legislative authority of the County with respect to the ethics law.

Chapter 8

Laws of Montgomery County 1985

AN ACT for the purpose of providing for the licensing of cats; providing for alternative means of identifying cats; providing for the establishment of differential license fees for altered dogs, regardless of sex; defining "altered"; requiring that a dog or cat brought to a veterinarian for treatment be licensed; requiring that the Department of Animal Control be notified if it is medically indicated that a dog or cat should not be vaccinated; repealing the amount of the license fee for commercial kennels; and generally relating to animal control.
